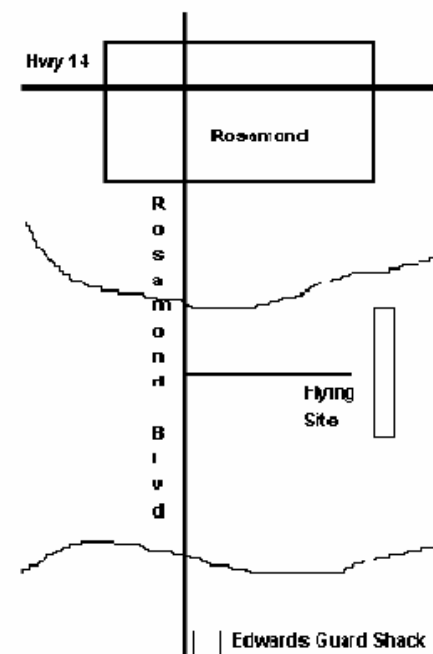
If you're not sure you'll enjoy the hobby, you can test fly the club trainer. You owe it to yourself to experience the thrill of flying.

CLUB MEETINGS: The Muroc Model Masters meet the first Tuesday of each month at 6 PM at Floyd's house, 3973 Knox, Rosamond. The meetings consist of important club business, a show and tell of airplanes or products, and product or technique demonstrations. It's a good time to meet other club members, and learn about building and flying.

Muroc Model Masters Flying Field

The primary flying field for the Muroc Model Masters is located on Rosamond Dry Lake just north of Rosamond Blvd. The dry lakes of Edwards are off limits to normal travel so please stay on the designated road out to the flying field. Edwards AFB Security Police patrol this area and your Model Masters Club card is your pass onto the lake bed. All guests must be accompanied by a member of the club.



Our flying site is the BEST site for both experimental aircraft and learning to fly. Most fields have a concrete runway a few hundred feet long and only 50 feet or so wide. Our flying surface is ¼ mile wide and 2 miles long, affording very long approaches and touchdowns and improving your chances of successful landings.
